Dear Mr. Peasley,

I have reviewed the autopsy and toxicology reports from the Medical Examiner regarding the death of Laura Bowboin.

I do not believe the cause of death as stated by the medical examiner. The level of ambien reported is not incompatible with life.

The circumstances surrounding Ms. Bowboin's death are suspicious and further investigation is warranted.

First, all toxicological testing should be repeated at a different laboratory. Testing should include gastric contents and cover drugs such as Fentanyl.

More extensive microscopic examination of tissues including the heart and kidney should be conducted.

If the hyoid bone and larynx are available they should be re-examined and radiographed. A thorough examination of the neck structures for evidence of strangulation or suffocation must be made.
